 - Did you dislike this book and would NOT recommend it to others? Why?
- Give a summary of the book
 - Include the beginning, middle, and end of the story
 - This may be handwritten OR typed and then glued onto the provided paper.
- Describe the author/illustrator by writing two or more sentences.
- Include pictures throughout your book jacket.

***** For the Back Cover** you will have the opportunity to have other students who have read the book you chose make a comment.

We will have a day in class for this activity! You will need to bring your book to school **December 3rd.** Seeing your book will help others recall if they have read it or not!

(Students will write their comments on a loose leaf piece of paper which you will then transfer to your book jacket, ensuring that it is done neatly) ③
